Topic	Austin Elementary Guidelines
Student Transportation/ Arrival/Dismissal Procedures	 Busing Procedures: Students will wear masks at all times on the bus due to inability to social distance. Assigned Seats (family members must sit together). Arrival Procedures: Bus riders will filter into the gym and sit by bus. Students must remain masked. Students will be dismissed to classrooms at 7:50 AM. Car riders will arrive at 8:00 AM or after and will filter directly to their classroom. All students will remain masked during any transition times. Upon arrival to classrooms, teachers will screen students (i.e. temp. checks/covid questions). Dismissal Procedures: Car riders will dismiss before bus riders on a staggered schedule (must remain masked in transition). Students will be dismissed by additional staff. Bus riders (late load) will be dismissed on a staggered schedule to the cafeteria and will be seated by bus designation (must remain masked). Students will be dismissed and monitored by additional staff. Bus riders (first load) will dismiss on a staggered schedule immediately following car riders (must remain masked in transition). Teachers will walk students out.

Teacher Arrival/Dismissal Procedures	 Arrival Procedures: Teachers must complete the Google Form pertaining to COVID-19 related questions/temp. check daily and submit to the school nurse by 7:50 AM.
Early Dismissal (student specific)	 Early pick up Parents/Guardians who need to pick up students early from school will need to buzz in at the gate and request the student. Parents must remain outside the building. The student will be escorted to their parent/guardian by a school staff member to be signed out.
Social Distancing Protocols for Staff and Students	 Masks Masks are required in all transition and holding areas and anywhere students/staff are within 6 feet proximity where social distancing is not achievable (including busing). N-95 not recommended
