Student Transportation/ Arrival/Dismissal Procedures	 <u>Busing Procedures:</u> Students will wear masks at all times on the bus due to inability to social distance. Assigned Seats (family members must sit together). <u>Arrival Procedures:</u> Bus and Car riders will filter into the gym and cafeteria. Students must remain masked when social distancing is not able to be achieved. Students will be dismissed to classrooms at 7:50 AM. Those who drive should not arrive before 7:50. All students will remain masked during any transition times. Upon arrival to 1st period class., teachers will screen students (i.e. temp. checks/covid questions). Any student arriving after 8:15 will have to go through the middle school office and be screened upon entry. <u>Dismissal Procedures:</u> Students will begin dismissal procedures at 3:00 staggering times for car riders, walkers, and bus riders.
Teacher Arrival/Dismissal Procedures	• <u>Arrival Procedures:</u> Teachers must complete the Google Form pertaining to COVID-19 related questions/temp. Check daily and submit to the school nurse by 8:15 AM.

Early Dismissal (student specific)	• Early pick up • Parents/Guardians who need to pick up students early from school will need to buzz in at the MS Office door and request the student. Parents must remain outside the building. The student will be released to their parents only through the MS Office door.
Social Distancing Protocols for Staff and Students	 Masks Masks are required on buses Masks will be required when moving throughout the building and anytime 6 feet of social distancing cannot be maintained. Students will be asked to provide a clean cloth or paper mask daily. N95 masks are not recommended.

Students will have assigned seats and designated areas for personal materials. Limit personal items that would be transported to and from school. Student lockers will not be provided.

Breakfast/ Lunch	 Every student picks breakfast up on their way to go eat in their first period classroom. Trash will be collected after breakfast Lunch will be provided in the classroom

Technology & Materials	 Students will have individual, assigned devices that will be sanitized daily.
