Community Eligibility Provision

Dear Parent or Guardian:

We are pleased to inform you that **SCOTT COUNTY SCHOOL DISTRICT 1** will be implementing a new option available to schools participating in the National School Lunch and School Breakfast Programs called the Community Eligibility Provision (CEP) for the 2019-2020 school year.

GREAT NEWS FOR ALL ENROLLED STUDENTS:

Students enrolled in **Austin Elementary, Austin Middle, and Austin High School** are eligible to receive one healthy breakfast and one lunch at school at **no charge** to your household each day of the 2019-2020 school year. No further action is required of you. Your child(ren) will be able to participate in these **meals-only** programs without having to pay a fee or submit an application. **Extras or A la carte items will still require funds for purchasing.**

Textbook Assistance is not included in this program so an application will still need to be filled out for those families that feel they qualify for Textbook Assistance unless otherwise notified by Scott County School District 1. Applications along with instructions will be available at registration, by calling Debbie Kilburn at the Central Office at 812-794-9620, at your child's school, or by visiting our website at www.scsd1.com. **Please be advised that if you do not apply for this benefit you will be held financially responsible for all textbook fees for the school year and will be billed accordingly.**
